NOTICE is hereby given that on 22nd March 1988, Falkirk District Council designated as a Conservation Area for the purposes of the above Acts an area of ground bounded by Camelon Road, Burnfoot Lane, Cockburn Street, Garthill Lane, Westburn Avenue and Maggie Wood's Loan (but excluding Garthill Gardens and Arnothill Gardens).

The effect of such designation is to require the local planning authority to advertise any application received by them for planning permission for any development which would in their opinion effect the character or appearance of the Conservation Area. The demolition of buildings and the removal of trees in the Conservation Area is prohibited, except with the consent of the local planning authority.

A plan showing the Conservation Area and the relevant written statement is available for inspection by the public during normal office hours on weekdays in the Planning Department on the second floor of the Municipal Buildings, Falkirk.
