NOTICE is hereby given, in accordance with section 36(1)(a) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974, that application has been made to the Highland River Purification Board by the Highland Regional Council for consent to discharge sewage effluent to the Abhainn Rìgh from the proposed Inchcree Sewerage System and Sewage Treatment Works as shown below:—

- (1) *Ref. No. 1/BO8/25/90* — 360 m<sup>3</sup>/d (cubic metres per day) of biologically treated sewage effluent at National Grid Reference NN 021627, Inchcree.
