## COLLEGE STREET, ABERDEEN

THE Grampian Regional Council propose to make The Grampian Regional Council (College Street Area, Aberdeen) (Traffic Management) Order, 19, under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order will be to revoke the existing one-way restriction on Marywell Street, and to close to vehicular traffic Marywell Street and Affleck Street at their junctions with College Street, Aberdeen.

Full details of the proposal are in the draft order, which, together with a map showing the the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the order, may be examined during normal office hours in the Roads Department, Woodhill House, Westburn Road,, Aberdeen, and at the offices of the Divisional Road Surveyor, St Nicholas House, Broad Street, Aberdeen.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed order should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by 19th June 1990. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matters to which they relate and the grounds on which they are made.

## B977 AND CLASS III IC, BELHELVE

NOTICE is hereby given that, on 28th May 1990, The Grampian Regional Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, made The Grampian Regional Council (B977 and Classified III IC Roads, Belhelvie) (40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 1990.

The effect of the order, which will come into operation on 1st June 1990, will be to prohibit any person from driving a vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on specified lengths of the B977 and classified III IC at Belhelvie.
