THE CENTRAL REGION (SCOTLAND'S CLOSE/
WAGGON ROAD, BO'NESS)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 1991

THE Central Regional Council made the above named Order under Sections 1(1) and 2, 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 at their meeting on 22nd May 1991.

The Order will prohibit waiting at any time on the sides and sections of Scotland's Close/Waggon Road, Bo'ness, detailed in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the relative plan, may be examined at the Regional Council's Offices, Viewforth, Stirling (Room 19) and at Falkirk District Council's Offices (within the Administration Department's Enquiry Office), Municipal Buildings, Falkirk during normal office hours free of charge.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the aforesaid Act or that any requirement therein has not been complied with, may, within six weeks from 22nd May 1991, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

<i>Roads in Bo'ness</i>	<i>Side and Section of Road on Which Waiting is Prohibited At Any Time</i>
Scotland's Close	On both sides thereof between its junction with North Street in a northerly direction to its termination point
Waggon Road	On the south kerbline thereof from a point in line with the eastern boundary of Scotland's Close in a westerly direction to a point in line with the western boundary of Scotland's Close a distance of four metres or thereby
