PESTICIDES

FOOD AND ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION ACT 1985

Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986

CONSENT B. SALE, SUPPLY AND STORAGE OF PESTICIDES

IN exercise of the power conferred by Regulation 6(b) of the Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986 (S.I. 1986/1510) (hereinafter referred to as "the regulations") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministers") hereby jointly give their consent to the sale, supply and storage of pesticides, in replacement of Consent B dated 20th January 1989, which is hereby revoked, subject forthwith to the conditions set out below.

Conditions subject to which consent to the sale, supply and storage of pesticides is given

1. It shall be the duty of every employer to ensure that a person in his employment who may be required to sell, supply or store a

pesticide during the course of that employment, is provided with such instruction and guidance as is necessary to enable that person to comply with the requirements in and under the regulations.

2. Any person who sells, supplies or stores a pesticide shall:
 - (a) take all reasonable precautions, particularly with regard to storage and transport, to protect the health of human beings, creatures and plants, to safeguard the environment, and in particular avoid the pollution of water; and
 - (b) be competent for the duties which he is called upon to perform.
3. No person shall sell, supply or otherwise market to the end-user an approved pesticide other than in the container supplied for that purpose by the holder of the approval of that pesticide, and under a label approved by the Ministers.
4. No person shall store for the purpose of sale or supply a pesticide approved for agricultural use in a quantity in excess of, at any one time, 200 kilogrammes or 200 litres or a similar mixed quantity unless he has obtained a certificate of competence recognised by the Ministers, or he stores that pesticide under the direct supervision of a person who holds such a certificate.
5. No person shall sell, supply or otherwise market to the end-user a pesticide approved for agricultural use unless he has obtained a certificate of competence recognised by the Ministers, or he sells or supplies that pesticide under the direct supervision of a person who holds such a certificate.
6. For the purposes of conditions 4 and 5, "a pesticide approved for agricultural use" means a pesticide (other than one with methyl bromide as an active ingredient) approved for use within one or more of the following fields of use:

Agriculture and horticulture (including amenity horticulture), forestry, in or near water (products for other than amateur, public hygiene or anti-fouling uses), industrial herbicides (such as weedkillers for use on land not intended for cropping).

CONSENT B/1. SUPPLY AND STORAGE OF PESTICIDES FOR SAFE DISPOSAL

Conditions (in addition to those numbered 1-6 above) subject to which consent to the supply and storage of pesticides for safe disposal is given.

7. In this part of this consent "pesticide for disposal" means any substance, preparation or organism for the supply and storage of which the Ministers have jointly given their approval provided that such pesticide is supplied and stored only for the purpose of its safe disposal.

Storage

8. No person shall store a pesticide for disposal other than in a container suitable for storage and transport of the contents.
9. No person shall store a pesticide for disposal unless the container is securely closed to prevent any of its contents escaping under normal conditions of storage and handling.
10. No person shall store a pesticide for disposal unless —
 - (a) he holds it in a secure store and separate from any pesticide intended for use; and
 - (b) he records in writing its location in that store.
11. (1) Every person who stores a pesticide for disposal shall ascertain and record in writing its name, or active ingredient or ingredients.

(2) Where the information specified in sub-paragraph (1) above cannot be ascertained from the original label or from stock, purchase or other records, the person storing the pesticide for disposal shall —

- (a) commission a competent person to identify that pesticide sufficiently for the purpose of its safe disposal; and
- (b) record in writing the date on which this action was taken and the name and address of the competent person.

12. Records under condition 10 and 11 above shall be dated when made and kept for a period of three years thereafter for inspection by any person duly authorised under section 19 of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985.

13. No person shall store a pesticide for disposal unless the container is clearly and legibly labelled with —

- (a) the warnings —
"Not for use";
"To remain sealed".
- (b) the name and address of the owner of the pesticide;
- (c) the date on which the information specified in paragraph (b) above was affixed;
- (d) the combined weight or best estimated weight of the container and its contents in kilogrammes;
- (e) the name of the pesticide, or its active ingredient or ingredients or, where condition 11(2) applies, information sufficient for the purpose of its safe disposal.

Supply

14. No person shall supply a pesticide for disposal except to a pesticide distributor or to a person who holds a current disposal licence issued to him by a disposal authority under section 5 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 and accompanied by a statement in writing of the name of the pesticide, or its active ingredient or ingredients, or of its identity for the purpose of its safe disposal, and of the information specified in condition 13(b), (c) and (d) in relation to that pesticide.

15. Every person who supplies a pesticide for disposal shall —

- (a) record in writing the date of supply; and
- (b) keep that record for a period of three years from that date of inspection by any person duly authorised under section 19 of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985.

16. Part B/1 of this consent shall expire on 31st March 1992.

TREASURY MINUTE dated 30th July 1991

THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury read Section 3(2) of the National Loans Act 1968 (1968 C.13 as amended) whereby any sums borrowed from the Public Works Loan Commissioners shall bear interest at such rates as the Treasury may determine from time to time in accordance with Section 5 of the said Act.

My Lords understand that the Public Works Loan Commissioners will be operating arrangements under which local authorities are permitted to borrow from the Commissioners up to a specified quota at a certain fixed rate of interest and in excess of such quota at one of two higher fixed rates.

In accordance therewith the Chancellor of the Exchequer now recommends that with effect from 31st July 1991 and until the coming into operation of a further determination:

- I.
