

5. Any person with custody or control of the apparatus at any time while it is in the United Kingdom and the importer shall keep a record in writing of the following in relation to the apparatus:

- a) the model number;
- b) the number in the consignment;
- c) the date of import;
- d) if acquired in the United Kingdom, the date of purchase;
- e) if disposed of in the United Kingdom, the date of disposal and the name and address of the purchaser; and
- f) in the case of the person who re-exports, the date of export and the completed consignment note confirming export.

for a period of 12 months from the date of purchase or import of the apparatus as the case may be or, in the case of the consignment note confirming export, for a period of 12 months from the date of export and shall make such records available for inspection on demand by a person authorised for that purpose by the Secretary of State.

6. This Authority shall remain in force until it is revoked by the Secretary of State by means of a further notice in the *London Gazette*.
7. Words and expressions used in this Authority shall have the same meaning as they have in the Order.
8. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the purposes of interpreting this Authority as if it were an Act of Parliament.
