ORDER 199 TO/1646

THE LOTHIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, propose to make an Order the effect of which will prohibit waiting, loading and unloading at any time on the south west side of Hermand Terrace, Edinburgh from a point 8 metres or thereby southeast of the extended southeast kerbline of Slateford Road in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 96 metres or thereby.

A copy of the draft Order together with (1) a map showing the roads affected and (2) a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined between the hours of 9.30 am and 3.30 pm Mondays to Fridays during the period 28th May 1993 to 18th June 1993 at Lothian Regional Council Headquarters, George IV Bridge, Edinburgh.
