MONKLANDS DISTRICT COUNCIL

THE CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

THE PROPOSED MONKLANDS DISTRICT SMOKE CONTROL AREA NO. 21 ORDER, 1993

1. NOTICE is hereby given that Monklands District Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 11 of the above Act, as amended, proposes to make an Order entitled "The Monklands District Smoke Control Area No. 21 Order, 1993" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area.
2. The proposed Order will not come into operation until at least six months after it is made by the District Council.
3. Subject to the exemptions provided by the proposed Order and by virtue of Section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £1,000 unless he can prove that the smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel.

The authorised fuels are:

Electricity, gas, anthracite including semi-anthracite, briquetted fuels carbonised in the process of manufacture, coke, coalite, dutch (sluiskil) coke doubles, low temperature carbonisation fuels, low volatile steam fuels, fluidised char binderless briquettes, "XL" Briquettes, "Ancit 40" and "Ancit 60" Briquettes, "Taybrite" Briquettes, "Anthracite N60" Briquettes, "Anthranor" and "Energo" Briquettes, "Antrex" Briquettes, "Centurion" Briquettes, "Clean Flame" Briquettes, "Extracite" Briquettes, "Fireglow" Briquettes, "Flame Light Pellets", "Home Fire" Briquettes, "Phurmacite" Briquettes, Pureheat ovoids, "Sovereign" Briquettes, "Maxiflame" Briquettes, "New Flame" Briquettes, "Roomheat" Briquettes, "Thermac" Briquettes and "Thermobrite" Briquettes.

4. A copy of the proposed Order (and of the map referred to therein) may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Director of Environmental Services, District Court Building, 453 Main Street, Coatbridge, from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m., Mondays to Fridays, during the period of six weeks from Monday, 31st May, 1993, to Friday, 9th July, 1993.

Within that period any person who will be affected by the proposed Order may object to its being made by writing to the Director of Administration and Legal Services, Monklands District Council, Municipal Buildings, Dunbeth Road, Coatbridge.

SCHEDULE

5. The area in Monklands District extending to 6,115 hectares or thereby and bounded on the north by the Airdrie/Glasgow railway line and proceeding in a southerly direction from its junction with the disused Airdrie Graham Street railway solum, across Hogg Street along the said railway solum thence along the Calderbank/Cairnhill public footpath to its junction with the midline of Calderbank Road. Thence westerly along Calderbank Road, Sikeside Road until it intersects with the midline of the public footpath, thence in a southerly direction along the said footpath until it intersects with the North Calder Water, thence following the said watercourse until it intersects with the midline of the disused railway solum. Thence following the said railway solum in a southerly direction until it intersects with the boundary of Monklands District. Thence following the said boundary in a south easterly direction until it intersects with the midline of Shotts Road. Thence in a north westerly direction, following the said boundary of Monklands District until it intersects with the midline of the Glasgow/Edinburgh Motorway. Thence in an easterly direction, following the said boundary of Monklands District until it intersects with the midline of Blairmuckhole and Forrestdyke Road, thence following the said boundary of Monklands District in a north westerly direction until it intersects with the midline of Airdrie Road. Thence westerly along Airdrie Road through Main Street, Plains, continuing south westerly along Airdrie Road until it intersects with the midline of Towers Road. Thence south easterly along Towers Road until it intersects with the Glasgow/Edinburgh railway line until it intersects with the midline of the public footpath. Thence in an easterly direction along the said footpath until it intersects with the North Calder Water, thence following the said watercourse until it intersects with the midline of the public footpath. Thence in a westerly direction following the said footpath until its intersection with the midline at Petersburn Road, thence south westerly along Petersburn Road until its intersection with the midline of Carlisle Road. Thence in a northerly direction following the said road until it intersects with the Glasgow/Edinburgh Railway line, thence in an easterly direction along the said railway line to its junction with the disused Airdrie Graham Street railway solum.
