GARTHDEE AREA, ABERDEEN

GRAMPIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL has made "The Grampian
Regional Council (Mannofield, Cults, Bieldside, Milltimber and
Garthdee Area, Aberdeen) (Area III South) (Traffic Management)
Order, 1994", under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of this order is as advertised in *The Press and Journal*
on 21st May, 1993, and in *The Edinburgh Gazette* of the same date;
namely to regulate the waiting of vehicles on specified lengths of
those roads listed in the schedule to this notice, to revoke specified
lengths of waiting restrictions on North Deeside Road, and to
prohibit loading and unloading on that length of the east side of
School Road extending between its junctions with South Lane and
School Crescent.

The exemptions to the waiting restrictions (but not the loading
restrictions) permit waiting:-

1. for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers;
2. for the purpose of loading or unloading goods;
3. where necessary in connection with any building operation or
demolition; the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the mainte-
nance of roads, or the supply of gas, electricity, water or
telegraphic services;
4. to enable a vehicle owned by a funeral undertaker or owner of
funeral vehicles to be used for a purpose connected with a fu-
neral, but only on occasions when it cannot conveniently be used
for such purpose on any other road; and
5. by disabled drivers.

The order also provides for one-way systems North Deeside Road
(slip road), Cults, Gowan Brae Road, Bieldside, Prospecthill Road,
Bieldside, Station Brae, Peterculter, and Kennerty Road, Peterculter.

Copies of the order as signed and sealed and the relevant map are
available for inspection during normal office hours at the offices of

the Director of Administration, Grampian Regional Council,
Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the order on
the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Act, or that the
relevant requirements arising from the Act have not been complied
with in relation to the order, may, within six weeks of 3rd June, 1994,
apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
