#### THE CENTRAL REGION (VARIOUS STREETS, GRANGEMOUTH) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION ON WAITING) (CONSOLIDATION AND AMENDMENT) ORDER 1995

THE CENTRAL REGIONAL COUNCIL made the above named Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 at their Meeting on 17th May 1995.
