THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT is planning to introduce Regulations under Section 140 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 entitled "The Environmental Protection (Controls on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer) Regulations 1995".

The intended effect of the proposed Regulations is to set out penalties for contravention of Council Regulation (EC) No 3093/94 on substances that deplete the ozone layer (OJ NO L333, 22.12.1994, p. 1), and to deal with matters arising out of or relating to the 1994 Regulation by:-

- prohibiting and restricting importation, landing and unloading of certain controlled substances;
- imposing a duty on persons having control of certain controlled substances to comply with provisions in the Regulation;
- conferring enforcement powers on customs officers, the Secretary of State, persons authorised by the Secretary of State and Health and Safety Inspectors; and
- creating a number of offences.

The 1995 Regulations will also amend the Environmental Protection (Non-Refillable Refrigerant Containers) Regulations 1994.
