(CONSOLIDATION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1995

THE CENTRAL REGIONAL COUNCIL propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1) to (3), 2(1) to (4) and 4(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will make permanent the current weight restriction of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight (with access) on the B8031 Coldoch Road.
