## COMPANY DIRECTORS DISQUALIFICATION ACT 1986

IN a petition presented to the Court of Session in terms of section 6 of the above Act at the instance of Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Trade and Industry in respect of William Stevenson Fyffe, the Court has, on 29th August 1995 ordered, *inter alia*, the following:-

"The Lord Ordinary, having considered the petition and proceedings, no Answers having been lodged, disqualifies the respondent William Stevenson Fyffe without leave of the Court from being a director of a company or in any way whether directly or indirectly being concerned or taking part in the promotion, formation or management of a company for a period of 7 years from this date; direct making of this order to be registered by the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry and appoints intimation hereof to be made

## COMPANY DIRECTORS DISQUALIFICATION ACT 1986

IN a petition presented to the Court of Session in terms of section 6 of the above Act at the instance of Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Trade and Industry in respect of Thomas Wilson, the Court has, on 8th August 1995 ordered, *inter alia*, the following:-

"The Lord Ordinary, having heard the Counsel for the Petitioner and the Party Respondent and having considered the petition and proceedings, no Answers having been lodged, disqualifies the respondent Thomas Wilson, without leave of the Court from being a director of a company or in any way whether directly or indirectly being concerned or taking part in the promotion, formation or management of a company for a period of 4 years from this date; directs the making of this Order to be registered by the Secretary of
