## NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A SUBMARINE PIPE-LINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

AMERADA HESS LIMITED hereby gives notice on behalf of itself, in accordance with the provisions of Part I of Schedule 4 to the Petroleum and Submarine Pipe-lines Act 1975 that it has made an application to the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry for the grant of an authorisation for the construction and use of a system of pipe-lines between the Scott Platform and subsea well locations within the Telford Field.
