THE POST OFFICE OVERSEAS PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No 18) SCHEME 1996

Coming into operation 15th April 1996

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969 and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:-

Commencement and citation

(i) This Scheme shall come into operation on 15th April 1. 1996 and may be cited as the Post Office Overseas Parcel Post Amendment (No. 18) Scheme 1996.

Arrangement of Paragraphs
