

## ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

THE A82 TRUNK ROAD (CRIANLARICH WESTERN  
BYPASS)

THE SECRETARY OF STATE hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:-

- a. An Order under sections 5(2) and 143(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 to provide for the construction of new lengths of trunk road and for Stirling Council to become the roads authority for lengths of old road which will cease to be trunk road.
- b. An Order under section 12(1) as read with sections 70(1) and 143(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 to provide for the construction, improvement and stopping up of various side roads in connection with the improvement of the A82 Trunk Road.

Copies of the Orders and relevant plans may be inspected, free of charge, during business hours, from 26th April 1996 to 7th June 1996 at the offices of The Scottish Office Development Department, Victoria Quay, Edinburgh; the offices of Stirling Council, Viewforth, Stirling and the Post Office, Criannlarich.

Any person aggrieved by these Orders, who desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provisions therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Road (Scotland) Act 1984 or that any requirements of the said Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within 6 weeks of 26th April 1996 make application to the Court of Session for the suspension of the operation of, or the quashing of, the Orders or any provision contained therein.
