TEST VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL recently considered an application from Hildon Limited, Broughton, Near Stockbridge, in Hampshire, for the Council to recognise a mineral water source, using the commercial designation Hildon Water, under the above Regulations.

The Natural Mineral Water Regulations, 1985 permits the Council to recognise a water source if the water satisfies certain criteria and parameters listed in schedule 1 of the Regulations. The criteria includes the physical and chemical characteristics of the water, microbiological analysis, toxic substances, freedom from pollution and stability.

All the criteria have been satisfied and an accredited laboratory has confirmed that the water was chemically and physically suitable for human consumption.

Take notice, therefore, that on the 13th March 1996, the Borough council of Test Valley recognised the designation of Hildon Borehole number 3 Water Supply obtained at Crown Farm, Broughton, Hampshire O.S reference 31453083 as natural mineral water for the purposes of the Natural Mineral Water Regulations 1985.
