FALKIRK COUNCIL

THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (FALKIRK TOWN CENTRE CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) ORDER 1997

FALKIRK COUNCIL propose to make Order under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will:

- (1) Introduce a controlled parking zone within which every section of road is subject to waiting restrictions other than lengths of the roads where parking places are designated.
- (2) The controlled zone will be in operation Monday to Saturday 8.45 am to 5.30 pm.
- (3) To consolidate and standardise the restrictions within the area of the controlled parking zone.
- (4) To introduce disabled parking bays on-street to provide convenient parking for disabled people at the most suitable locations.
- (5) To introduce loading bays in streets where businesses find it most difficult to load and unload.
- (6) To introduce a limited number of residents parking bays.
- (7) To extend the existing pay and display area to include Callendar Road, East Bridge Street, Kemper Avenue, Hope Street, Weir Street.
- (8) To introduce designated parking bays, some with time restrictions.
- (9) To move the taxi rank in Kirk Wynd/Vicar Street to the south side of Newmarket Street.

Full details of this proposal are in the draft Order which, together with a copy of the relative plan and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for promoting the Order, may be examined at the Council's

Offices, Municipal Buildings, Falkirk, Law and Administration's Reception and at the One-Stop Shop, Callendar Square, Falkirk during normal office hours free of charge for three weeks from 11th December 1997.
