PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPELINES ACT 1975

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A SUBMARINE PIPE-LINE
WORKS AUTHORISATION

PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY UNITED KINGDOM hereby give notice on behalf of itself, in accordance with the provisions of Part I of Schedule 4 to the Petroleum and Submarine Pipe-lines Act 1975 that they have made an application to the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry for the grant of an authorisation for the construction and use of a system of pipe-lines between the Amerada Hess operated AH-011 facility and the subsea Renee and Rubie fields.

A map (or maps) delineating the route of the proposed pipe-lines and providing certain further information may be inspected free of charge at the places listed in the Schedule to this notice from 10am to 4pm on each weekday from the date that this notice is published until the date mentioned in the next paragraph of this notice.

Pursuant to a direction of the Secretary of State, representations with respect to the application may be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry at the Oil & Gas Office, Atholl House, 86-88 Guild Street, Aberdeen AB11 6AR (marked FAO Mr I Furneaux, Offshore Pipelines Authorisations) not later than 20th March 1998 and should bear the reference "ABE 10/1/ RenRubie" and state the grounds upon which the representations are made.

RAILWAY ACT 1993

National Rail Enquiry Scheme

The franchised train operators are subject to an enforcement order which requires them to ensure that 90% of calls made to the National Rail Enquiry Scheme (NRES) (the 0345 484950 number) are answered. The train operators failed to meet this requirement in September and October last year and were fined a total of £350,000 for those failures. Since then NRES has been answering in excess of 90% of calls made to the number. Accordingly the Regulator is satisfied that NRES has arrangements in place to meet the call answering requirement, and that therefore the enforcement order is no longer required.
