THE Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in relation to England and the Secretary of State for Wales in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 32(3) of the Animal Health Act 1981(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury in accordance with the said section 32(3), hereby make the following Order:

S.I. 1998 No. 2073

This Order may be cited as the Brucellosis and Tuberculosis (England and Wales) Compensation (Amendment) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 26th August 1998.

This Order amends the Brucellosis and Tuberculosis (England and Wales) Compensation Order 1978 (S.I. 1978/1483 as amended by S.I. 1981/1412 and S.I. 1996/1352).
