NOTICE OF THE ISSUE OF A SUBMARINE PIPE-LINE WORKS AUTHORISATION

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by BG International, whose registered address is 100 Thames Valley Park, Reading, RG6 1PT, for the construction of a 273.1 millimetre Pipeline and 110 millimetre Pipelines between Mercury Field Development and Neptune Platform within the Easington Catchment Area Development

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the 273.1 mm pipe-line shall only be used to convey Multiphase Hydrocarbons and the 110 mm pipelines (chemical injection umbilical) shall only be used to convey Methanol and Corrosion Inhibitors. The pipe-lines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

BG International has been appointed operator of the pipe-lines.
