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

SINCLAIR ROAD - PROHIBITION OF WAITING

Aberdeen City Council has made "The Aberdeen City Council (Sinclair Road, Aberdeen) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1999" under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the order is as advertised in *The Press and Journal* of 25th August 1998, and in *The Edinburgh Gazette* of the same date (issue no 24457); namely, to introduce a prohibition of waiting at any time on the north side of Sinclair Road, Aberdeen, immediately west of the access to Shell UK Expro (i.e directly opposite Baxter Street) for a distance of twenty metres. 
