PUBLICATION OF DECISIONS

Pursuant to regulation 6(9) of the above Regulations, the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that, in the period from 1st June 1999 to 30th June 1999, he gave a direction in respect of 19 relevant projects that the application for consent for those projects need not be accompanied by an environmental statement. The projects were as follows:
