MEMORANDUM.

His Majesty has been pleased to approve of the 44th regiment of foot being permitted to bear on its colours and appointments, in addition to any other badges or devices which may have heretofore been granted to the regiment, the words "Badajoz" and "Salamanca," in commemoration of the distinguished services of the regiment at the siege of Badajoz, on 16th March 1812, and at the battle of Salamanca, on 22d July 1812.
