PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

This day the Right Honourable William Carr Lord Beresford, G. C. B. was, by his Majesty's command, sworn of his Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, and took his place at the Board accordingly.

His Majesty having been pleased to appoint the Right Honourable William Carr Lord Beresford, G. C. B. to be Governor of the Island of Jersey, his Lordship this day took the oath appointed to be taken by the Governor of that Island.

DOWNING-STREET—FEBRUARY 8, 1821.

The King has been pleased to appoint Lieutenant-General Sir Henry Warde, K. C. B. to be Captain-General and Governor in Chief in and over the Island of Barbadoes.

The King has been pleased to appoint Major-General Sir Thomas Brisbane, K. C. B. to be Governor of New South Wales and its dependencies.
