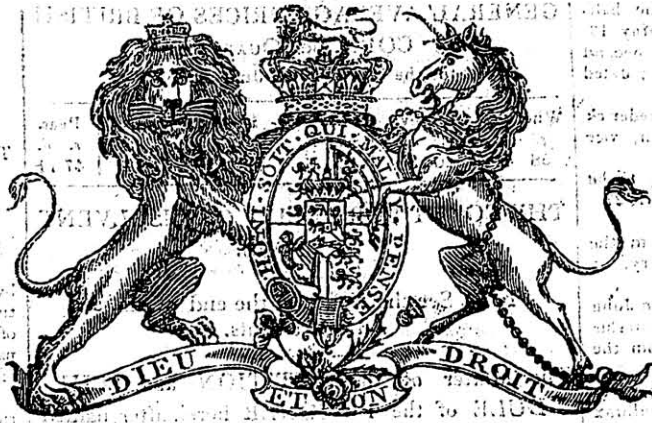

 - " Busaco,"

in commemoration of the distinguished conduct of the Regiment at the battle of Busaco, on 27th September 1810.
