His Majesty has been pleased to approve of the 4th or King's Own Regiment of Foot, and of the 44th Regiment of Foot bearing on their colours and appointments, in addition to any other badges or devices which may have heretofore been granted to those Regiments, the word

"Bladensburg,"

in commemoration of the distinguished conduct of those Corps in the action on the Heights above Bladensburg, on 24th August 1814.

His Majesty has been pleased to approve of the Ceylon Regiment bearing the name of the "Ceylon Rifle Regiment."
