St. James's Palace, June 30, 1827.

This day the Count Ofalia, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary on a special mission from the King of Spain, had an audience of His Majesty to deliver his credentials; to which he was introduced by the Lord Viscount Dudley and Ward, His Majesty, Phinoisty Security of States of Sta His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign affairs, and conducted by Sir Robert Chester, Knt.
