Copy of a letter from Rear-Admiral Bazely, Commanding Officer of his Majesty's ships and vessels in the Downs, to Evan Nepean, Esq. dated Feb. 5, 1797.

Enclosed herewith is a copy of a letter I have received from Captain Bazely, of his Majesty's sloop Harpy, giving an account of the Lion cutter having captured a small French privateer, off Dungeness.

Harpy, off Dungeness, Feb. 3. 1797, Six o'clock, P.M.

I have the honour to acquaint you, that, at five o'clock this evening, stretching close in with Dungeness Point, we fell in with his Majesty's armed cutter Lion, bringing too a floop, aftern of a convoy running to the Eastward, which proved to be the Reguin, Republican privateer, belonging to Dieppe, with 20 men, and armed with musquets.
