Extract of a letter from Captain Payne, commander of

his Majesty's ship Impetueux, to Evan Nepean, Esq. dated at sea, June 13, 1797.

Take this opportunity of acquainting you of the position of the detachment of the western squadron with me, by the Zoee, a French privateer thip, copper bottomed, mounting twenty gune, (four of which she had thrown overboard in chace) and one hundred and twenty men; she was chaced by the squadrons and captured by the Phæton the evening before last, and had taken nothing since she left Brest four days ago.
