**L**ETTERS patent have passed the Great Seal of this kingdom, containing his Majesty's Grant to the Right Hon. Hon. Edmond Henry Lord Glentworth, of the office and offices of Clerk of the Hanaper and Clerk of the Crown, in his Majesty's High Court of Chancery in this kingdom.
