Copy of a letter from Capt. CHARLES STIRLING, Commander of his Majetty's fhip Jason, to Evan Nepean, Esq. dated at Sea, the 23d of February 1798.

SIR.

HIS Majesty's ship under my command this day captured Le Coureur, a corvette belonging to the Government of France, and commanded by officers of the navy, but lent to the merchants for a privateer. She mounts 24 guns, and has 150 men.
