This day, the Lords being met, the Royal Affent was given, by Commission, to "An Act to empower his Majesty to secure and detain such persons as his Majesty shall suspect are conspiring against his Person and Government."

The King has been pleased to grant unto John Dalrymple, of Park Place, in the parish of Old Luce, in the county of Wigton, Esq. only surviving son and heir of James Dalrymple, of Dunragit, in the said parish of Old Luce, his Royal license and authority, that he and his iffue, by Sufanna his wife, only furviving daughter of Sir Thomas Hay, and fifter and heir of Sir Thomas Hay, late of Park Place aforefaid, Baronets, deceased, may take and use the furname of Hay, instead of that of Dalrymple, and also bear the arms of Hay only; such arms being first duly exemplified according to the laws of arms: and also to order that his Majesty's said concession and declaration be registered in his College of Arms.

The King has also been pleased to confer the dignity of a Baronet of the kingdom of Great Britain upon the faid John Hay, Efq. and to the heirs-male

of his body lawfully begotten.
