ORDER OF THE MEDJIDIE.

WHITEHALL, March 2, 1858.

THE Queen has been pleased to give and grant unto the undermentioned Officers Her Majesty's royal licence and permission that they may accept and wear the insignia of the several Classes of the Imperial Order of the Medjidie attached to their respective names, which His Imperial Majesty the Sultan hath been pleased to confer upon them as a mark of His Majesty's approbation of their distinguished services before the enemy during the late War, or as having been actually and entirely employed in His Majesty's Service, and that they may enjoy all the rights and privileges thereunto belonging, viz.—
