INSTALLATION of HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE PRINCE OF WALES as  
a Knight of the Most Illustrious Order of St Patrick.

OFFICE OF ARMS, DUBLIN CASTLE,  
18th April 1868.

THIS day having been appointed for the Installation of HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE PRINCE OF WALES as a Knight of the Most Illustrious Order of St Patrick, the Streets were lined with Military from the Castle, down Cork Hill, and along Dame Street, College Green, Grafton Street, Nassau Street, Dawson Street, Stephen's Green, York Street, Aungier Street, Bishop Street, and the South Close, to the West Gate of the Cathedral: Sentinels were placed at the avenues to the Cathedral, and at the gates where Spectators were allowed to enter: the Streets in the line of the Procession were well kept, and no Carriages of any description, except those of His Excellency's Household, and of the Knights, Esquires, and Officers of the Order, were permitted to pass after Half-past Two o'clock, until the Procession had returned to the Castle.

His Excellency The GRAND MASTER (THE MARQUIS OF ABERCORN, K.G.), HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE PRINCE OF WALES, K.G., and HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE DUKE OF CAMBRIDGE, K.G., proceeded in State from the Castle to the Cathedral.

The Knights, Esquires, Officers of the Order, &c., assembled at the Cathedral at Three o'clock; the Installed Knights in their Mantles and Collars, the Uninstalled Knight, HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE PRINCE OF WALES, without Mantle or Collar.

His Excellency was received at the Cathedral by the Dean and Chapter, and conducted to the Chapter-Room in the following order:—
