ART. 6. Any infraction of the preceding regulations shall be reported by the agents entrusted with the "surveillance" of the rivers and canals, and any other agents of public management having power for that purpose, according to the provisions of the law of the 29th Floreal, in the year X, as well as the Decrees of the 16th December 1811, and 10th April 1812; and shall be punished by the penalties laid down in Art. 1 of the law of the 6th March 1818, provided that the law shall not have stated the penalties which shall be specially applicable.
