NOTICE is hereby given, in terms of the Act 16 Victoria, cap. 28, sec. 2, that the Sheriff of the County of Forfar, with the consent of Her Majesty's Advocate for Scotland, proposes to increase and otherwise alter the numbers, situation, and arrangement of the existing Polling Districts and Polling Places in the said County, so that at all future Parliamentary Elections for the said County the Electors shall respectively poll or vote at the places after specified, that is to say:—
