PRESENT.

The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS by an Act passed in the Session of Parliament held in the 35th and 36th years of Her Majesty's reign (chapter 62), intituled 'An Act to amend and extend the provisions of the Law of Scotland on the subject of Education, it was, amongst other things, enacted, that the Board of Education established by the said Act should endure for the term of three years from and after the passing of the said Act, with power to Her Majesty, by Order in Council made before the expiration of that term, to extend the same for a further period of not more than two years:

And whereas the period for which the said Board of Education was established will expire on the

6th day of August 1875, and it is deemed expedient that that period should be extended for a further

term of two years:

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her Majesty by the said Act, and by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, Her Majesty is pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the term for which the said Board of Education for Scotland was established by the said Act, shall be, and the same is hereby extended for a further period of two years from the 6th of August 1875.
