This day had audience of Her Majesty:-

General Sergio Camargo, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the United States of Colombia, to deliver his Credentials;

To which audience he was introduced by the Earl of Derby, Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs.

Whereas by the third section of 'The Public Offices Fees Act, 1866,' it is provided that all or any of the Stamps to be used under the said Act shall be impressed or adhesive as the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury from time to time direct.

And whereas by notice dated the 1st day of December 1866, published in the London Gazette, the Fees payable in the Companies Registration Office from and after the 31st day of December 1866, were ordered to be collected by means of Stamps under the regulations then promulgated.

Now, we, being two of the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers given to us in the third section of the said Act, do hereby order and direct in respect of Fees payable on Inspections or Searches in the Companies Registration Office, that from and after the 1st April next, the said Fees shall be denoted by Impressed Stamps only, and not by Adhesive Stamps, as heretofore.

Given under our hands at the Treasury Chambers, Whitehall, this twenty-eighth day of March one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight.
