ALTERATIONS IN THE POLLING PLACES IN RENFREWSHIRE.

I DO hereby give notice that I propose, in virtue of the powers conferred upon me, as Sheriff of the County of Renfrew, by the Act 16 Vict. cap. 28, sec. 2, to increase the number and alter the situation and arrangement of the existing Polling Places and Districts within the County of Renfrew, with reference to the election of a Member of Parliament for said County, and to appoint the same to be in future as follows, viz.:--

1st POLLING DISTRICT.

POLLING PLACE, PAISLEY.

Abbey Parish, excluding parts within the boundaries of the Parliamentary Burgh of Paisley and Police Burgh of Johnstone.

Parish of Renfrew, excluding part within the Parliamentary boundary of Bargh of Renfrew. Parish of Inchinnan.

2D POLLING DISTRICT.

POLLING PLACE, JOHNSTONE.

Parish of Kilbarchan, part of Abbey Parish within the boundary of the Police Burgh of Johnstone.

3D POLLING DISTRICT.

POLLING PLACE, HOUSTON.

Parish of Houston and Killellan and Parish of Erskine.
