

BUYERS, at great risk to his life, swam to his assistance, and with difficulty brought him back to the boat. They then managed to right the boat, and got inside her. Lawrie was, however, washed out of the boat by a heavy sea, but BUYERS again saved his life and pulled him back into the boat by means of one of the boards at the bottom of the boat. Soon after, when close to the light, the two survivors were picked up by a junk, were kindly treated, and landed at Shanghai.
