Bengal Staff Corps	Captain John Cook.	For a signal act of valour at the action of the Peiwar Kotal on the 2d December 1878, in having, during a very heavy fire, charged out the entrenchments with such impetuosity that the enemy broke and fled, when, perceiving, a the close of the méleé, the danger of Majo Galbraith, Assistant Adjutant-General, Kurur Column Field Force, who was in personal conflict with an Afghan soldier, Captain Cook distracted his attention to himself, and aiming a sword on which the Douranee avoided, sprang upon him and, grasping his throat, grappled with him. They both fell to the ground. The Douranee, most powerful man, still endeavouring to use hir rifle, seized Captain Cook's arm in his teeth until the struggle was ended by the man being shot through the head.
