The Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Act, 1878 (in this

Order referred to as the Act of 1878), and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the twenty-third day of November one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine; and words in this Order have the same meaning as in the Act of 1878.

2. This Order extends to Great Britain only.

3. Article 13 of The Foreign Animals Order is hereby further revoked as far as it relates to sheep brought from the United States of America and declares that the same may be landed without being subject under the Act of 1878 or under that Order to slaughter or to quarantine.
