CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION,

The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give
notice, that the following Regulations have been
approved by the Lords Commissioners of Her
Majesty's Treasury, viz. :—

SPECIAL REGULATIONS (Supplementary to the
General Regulations issued 8th April 1872,
and amended by subsequent notices in the
London Gazette) respecting Open Competitive
Examinations for the situation of Clerk in the

Departments of Her Majesty's General Register
House, Edinburgh.

N.B.—These Regulations are liable to alteration
for future Examinations.

1. The limits of age for this situation are 18
and 23, and candidates must be of the prescribed
age on the first day of the competitive examina-
tion.

2. No candidate will be eligible who has not
within the last five years served for at least two
years in the office of a Writer to the Signet, a
Solicitor, or a Law Agent.

3. The competitive examination will be in the
following subjects, viz. :—

Handwriting.
Orthography.
Arithmetic.
Copying M.S. (to test accuracy).
Indexing or Docketing.
Digesting Returns into Summaries.
English Composition.
Geography.
English History.
Book-keeping.

Candidates will be at liberty to offer themselves
for examination in any or all of these subjects.
No subjects are obligatory.

4. No candidate can be admitted to the com-
petition who has not previously satisfied the Civil
Service Commissioners that he possesses the
