**WHITEHALL, SEPT. 4. 1802.**

The King has been pleased to grant the dignity of a Baron of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland unto Archibald Dickson, of Hardingham Hall, in the county of Norfolk, Esq. Admiral of the blue squadron of his Majesty's fleet, and the heirs male of his body lawfully begotten, with remainder to his nephew Archibald Collingwood Dickson, Esq. Captain in the Royal Navy (eldest son of William Dickson, Esq. also Admiral of the blue squadron of his Majesty's fleet), and the heirs male of his body lawfully begotten.—Provided such his Majesty's concession be registered in his College of Arms, otherwise to be void and of none effect.
