The Queen has been graciously pleased to confer 'The Albert Medal of the First Class' upon William Cole, Police Constable in the A Division of the Metropolitan Police Force, for conspicuous gallantry displayed at an Explosion in Westminster Hall, on the 24th of January 1885.

#### WHITEHALL, February 2, 1885.

The Queen has been pleased to give and grant unto James Richardson Gibson, Esq., Director-General of the Egyptian Land Survey, Her Royal licence and authority that he may accept and wear the Insignia of the Third Class of the Order of

the Osmanich, which His Highness the Khedive of Egypt, authorised by His Imperial Majesty the Sultan, has been pleased to confer upon him, in recognition of his services whilst actually and entirely employed by His Highness beyond Her Majesty's Dominions.
