"That all Persons interested in or intisled unto fuch of the Bills payable in Course of the Navy or Victualling Offices, or for Transports, made out on or before the 31st of December 1762, as have not been converted into Annuities after the Rate of Four per Centum per Annum, in pursuance of an Act of the last Session of Parliament, who shall, on or before the 1st Day of March next, carry the same (after having had the Interest due thereupon to the 25th of March 1763, inclusive, computed and marked upon the faid Bills at the Navy or Victuallingoffice respectively) to the Treasurer of His Majesty's Navy, to be marked or certified, by him or his Pay-master. .
