cers and Seamen who shall make any fuch Seizure, in fuch Proportions, and in fuch Manner, as His Majefty, Ilis Heirs and Succeffors, shall think fit to order and direct, by any Order or Orders of Council, or by any Proclamation or Proclamations to be made or iffued from Time to Time for that Purpose : And whereas by one other A& passed in the last Session of Parliament, entituled, " An A& for grant-" ing certain Duties in the British Colonics and Plan-" tations in America, for continuing, amending and " making perpetual an Act paifed in the Sixth Year " of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the " Second, (intituled, An Act for the better fecuring and encouraging the Trade of His Majefly's Su-" gar Colonies in America) for applying the Produce " of fuch Duties, and of the Duties to arife by Vir-" tue of the faid Act, towards defraying the Expences " of defending, protecting, and fecuring, the faid "Colonies and Plantations; for explaining an Act " made in the Twenty Fifth Year of the Reign of "King Charles the Second, (intituled, An Act for the Encouragement of the Greenland and Eafland "Trades, and for the better fecuring the Plantation "Trades, and for altering and difallowing feveral "Drawbacks on Exports from this Kingdom, and " more effectually preventing the clandeftine Con-" veyance of Goods to and from the faid Colonies " and Plantations, and improving and fecuring the " Trade between the fame and Great Britain"; it is, amongst other Things enacted, That all Penalties and Forfeitures inflicted by that, or any other Act or Acts of Parliament relating to the Trade and Revenues of the British Colonies or Plantations in America, which shall be incurred and recovered there, (except fuch Seizures as shall be made at Sea by the Commanders or Officers of His Majefty's Ships or Vessels of War duly authorized to make Seizures) shall be divided, after deducting the Charges of Profecution from the Gross Produce thereof, into three Parts; and that one Part of the nett Produce thereof thould be paid into the Hands of the Collector of His Majefly's Cuftoms at the Port or Place where fuch Penalties or Forfeitures thould be recovered for the Use of His Majelty, His Heirs and Succeffors; one other Third to the Governor of the Colony, and the other Third to the Seizer or Profecutor ; and that one Molety of all fuch Seizures as should be made at Sea by His Majesty's Ships and Vessels as aforefaid, and of the Penalties and Forfeitures recovered thereon, first deducting the Charges as aforcfaid, shall be paid as aforetaid to the Collector of His Majesty's Customs, to and for the Use of His Majefty, His Heirs and Succeffors; and the other Moiety to him or them who shall Seize, Inform, and Sue for the fame ; fubject nevertheless to such Distribu. tion of the Produce of the Seizures fo made at Sea, as well with Regard to the Moiety therein before granted to His Majefty, His Heirs, and Succeffors, as with Regard to the other Moiety given to the Seizer or Profecutor, as His Majefty, His Heirs and Succeffors shall think fit to order and direct by any Order or Orders of Council, or by any Proclamation or Proclamations to be made for that Purpofe; His Majesty taking the fame into his Royal Confideration, is hereby pleafed, purfuant to the Powers vefted in him by the faid Acts of Parliament, and by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, direct and appoint, that the Moiety, or other Part of all and every the Seizure and Seizures that have been, or shall be made by Virtue of the first mentioned Act, and granted to the Officers and Seamen as aforefaid, and the Moiety of Seizures granted by the faid last mentioned Act, be divided in the following Proportions, viz.

If. With Regard to Seizures made by the Officers and Men of Ships and Sloops of War.

To the Captain or Captains of any fuch Ships or Sloops who shall be actually on Board at the Seizure of any Smuggling Veffel or prohibited Goods, Three Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them : To the Captains of Marines and Land Forces, Sea Lieutenants and Mafters on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongst them : To the Lieutenants and Quarter Masters of Marines, and Lieutenants, Enfigns, and Quarter Maiters of Land Forces, Boatlwain, Gunner, Purfer, Carpenter, Mafter's Mate, Surgeon, Pilot, and Chaplain, on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops, One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongst them : To the Midshipmen, Secretary to Flag Officers, Captain's Clerk, Master Sailmaker, Carpenter's Mates, Boat-swain's Mates, Gunner's Mates, Master at Arms, Corporals, Yeomen of the Sheets, Coxswain, Quarter Masters, Quarter Master's Mates, Surgeon's Mates, Yeomen of the Powder Room, and Serjeants of Marines, or Land Forces on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops, One Eighth Part to be equally divided amongft them : To the Trumpeters, Quarter Gunners, Car-penter's Crew, Steward, Cook, Armourer, Steward's Mate, Cook's Mate, Gunímith, Cooper, Swabber, Ordinary Trumpeter, Barber, Able Seamen, Ordi-nary Seamen, and Marine, or other Soldiers, and all other Perfons doing Duty, or affifting on Board any fuch Ships or Sloops, Two Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them.

zd. With Regard to Seizures made by the Officers and Men of Cutters commanded by Lieutenants.

To the Lieutenant commanding fuch Cutter, who shall be actually on Board at the Seizure of any Smuggling Veffel, or Prohibited Goods, One Half Part : To the Second Mafter and Pilot, or Mafter's Mate and the Midshipmen on Board any such Cutter, One Eighth Part : The Second Mafter and Pilot, or Mafter's Mate, to have Two Third Parts thereof, and the Midshipman to have the Remainder ; but if there should happen to be a Pilot Extraordinary on Board at the making of any fuch Seizure, the Second Master and Pilot, or Master's Mate, is, in that Cafe, to have one Moiety of the faid Eighth Part, and the other Moiety is to be equally divided between the Pilot Extraordinary and Midshipman : To the Clerk and Steward, Boatfwain's Mate, Gunner's Mate, Carpenter's Mate, and Surgeon's Mate on Board any fuch Cutter, One Eighth Part: To the Able Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and all other Perfons doing Duty and assisting on Board any such Cutter, Two Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them.

3d. With regard to Seizures made by Ships or Sloops of War in Conjunction with Cutters.

That in all fuch Cafes, the Moiety or other Part which is given to the Officers and Men who fhall make fuch Seizure, be divided into fo many equal Parts or Shares, as there may be Ships or Sloops and Cutters concerned therein; and that those Shares be distributed to the Officers and Men of the Ships or Sloops and Cutters according to the aforegoing Proportions.

And His Majefly doth hereby further order, direct, and appoint. That in the Cafe of Seizures made at Sea in any of the Colonies Abroad, belonging to the Crown of Great Britain, by His Majefly's Ships or Veffels, being Part of the Squadron, or acting under the Orders of a Flag Officer, or a Commodore with a Captain under him, fuch Flag Officer or Commodore fhall have One Fourth Part of the Moiety or other Part of the faid Seizures directed by the faid laft mentioned Act to be paid to the Collector of His Majefly's
