jesty's Customs, or reserved by former Acts for His Majesty's Use: And in Case any Sea Captain, inferior Commission or Warrant Sea Officers, belonging to any such Ship or Vessel, for whom any Shares of Seizures are hereby allowed, be absent at the Time of making such Seizure, the Share of such Sea Captain, inferior Commission or Warrant Sea Officer, shall be cast into the Share's hereby allowed to the Trumpeters, Quarter Gunners, Carpenter's Crew, Steward, Cook, Armourer, Steward's Mate, Cook's Mate, Gunsmith, Cooper, Swabber, Ordinary Trumpeter, Barber, Able Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and Marine or other Soldiers, and all other Persons doing Duty or affifting on board any fuch Ship or Vessel, to be equally divided amongst them: Provided, that if any Officer or Officers on Board of any fuch Ship or Sirops at the Time of making such Seizures, shall have more Commissions or Offices than One, he or they shall be intitled only to the Share which, according to the abovementioned Distribution, shall belong to his or their respective superior Commissions or Offices. And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, and the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, are to cause His Majesty's Pleasure hereby signified, to be duly complied with.

Petersburg, September 21. M. Mirowitz's Trial was concluded Yesterday. He was condemned to be broke upon the Wheel; but was told, that her Imperial Majesty's Mercy would be so far extended to him, as to mitigate his Punishment into the less severe Death of being beheaded: He is to be executed on Wednesday next.

Petersburg, September 28. M. Mirowitz, in pur-fuance of his Sentence, was publickly beheaded on Wednesday last: He behaved at his Execution, as he had done throughout the whole Transaction, with the greatest Resignation. Six of the Soldiers and Under Officers, who were engaged with him, run the Gantelop the same Day: They were so severely whipp'd, that, it is said, three of them are since dead. Many more are to be punished. One Uskakow, a Lieutenant in the Regiment of Welikolutz, who was privy to the Delign, was accidentally drowned in his Way from Smolensko.

Liston, October 3. The Count de Welsperg, the Emperor's Minister at this Court, being recovered from his Indisposition, had his sirst Audience of their Most Faithful Majesties and the Royal Family on Sunday last the 30th of September: And on Monday their Majellies and the Court fat out for Mafra, to be present at the Festival of St. Francisco de Assis; and will reside there about ten or twelve Days to take the Diversion of Hunting in the Park: M. da Cunha

attends their Majesties.

His Britannick Majesty's Ship Guadalupe, Captain Ruthven, arrived here on Saturday the 29th, in her

Way to Gibraltar and Minorea.

Genoa, October 6: Advice is received that the Male-Contents in Corfica continued the Siege of San Fiorenza, and had erected two new Batteries to push it with greater Vigour. Two Days ago the Re-publick fent an armed Bark, with Sixty Soldiers, and two other Barks laden with Flour, and other Provisions, to relieve the Garrison, and bring hither the Sick and Wounded; they are to touch at Bastia, to bring back Part of that Garrison; and the Republick has hired some other Vessels to go to Corfica, to bring hither all the Genoese Troops, as soon as the French are put in Possession of the Places, which they are to garrison in that Island.

The present Doge's Dignity expires on the 25th

of November next.

Florence, October 6. The Obstacles, which had hitherto prevented the Conclusion of the Negotiation between the Emperor and the Pope, for the Sale of some Allodial Estates, which he possessed in the Dutchy of Urbino as Great Duke of Tuscany, having very lately been removed, the Ratification of the Contract was exchanged by Baron St. Odil, and the Pope's Secretary of State Cardinal Torrigiani, on the 22d of last Month.

On Thursday Marshal Botta celebrated the Em-

peror's Name-Day; and entertained at Dinner the Members of the Regency, the Foreign Ministers, and many others; and in the Evening made a great

Assembly for the Ladies.

Vienna, Ostober 6. Thursday last, being his Im-perial Majesty's Name-Day, was observed at Schonbrun with the usual Solemnities.

This Evening the King of the Romans, and the Archduke Leopold, fet out for Moravia and Bohemia.

Hamburg, Ollober 16. The Baron de Scheffer, his Swedish Majesty's Ambassador to the French King, passed through this City on Sunday last in his

Way to Stockholm.

We hear from Warfaw that Count Keyferling, the Russian Ambassador, died there on the 30th past.
