Hague, December 1. The Dutch East India Company have had the Misfortune to lose the last homeward bound Ship from Batavia which was expected this Year. The Ship was wrecked within Three Leagues of the Texel, in a Storm a few Nights ago; and, except Five or Six Sailors, the Whole was loft, amongst whom were several Passengers, whose Names are not yet known.
